### - Gender and Development

The project focused on the lived experiences of women in academia. The study looked at women in academia from two points of view: firstly, it observed how their home life may be different or may affect their work life in different ways than it did for their male counterparts. Secondly, it looked at their work lives and the kinds of environments they faced at work. Information was gathered through in-depth interviews with both male and female instructors at LUMS, across various disciplines, and then compiled and analysed.
